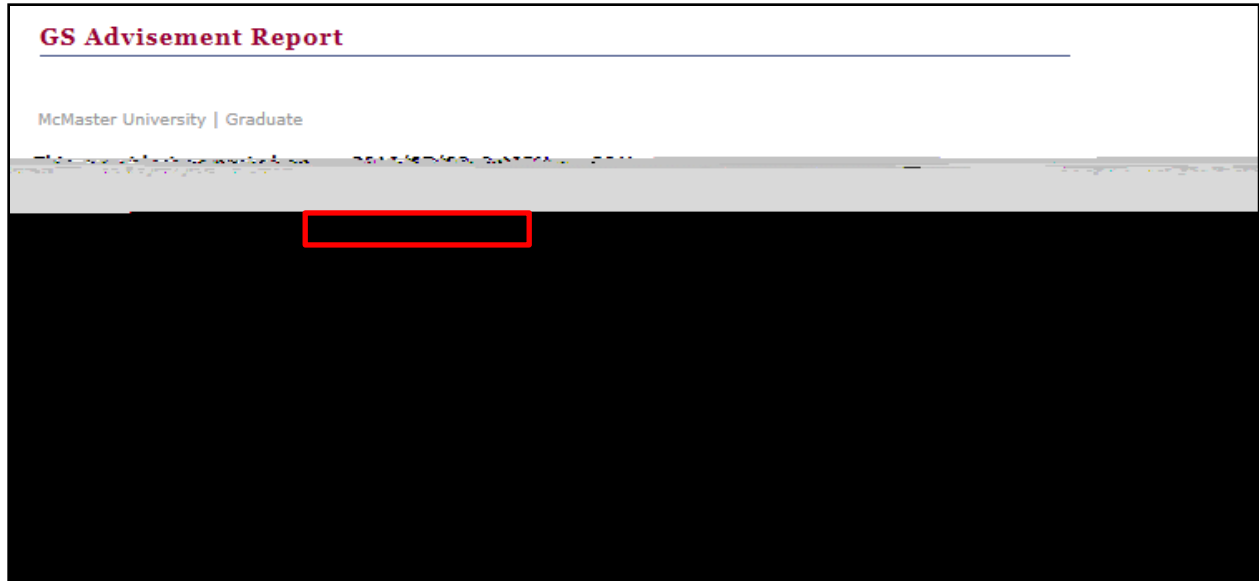
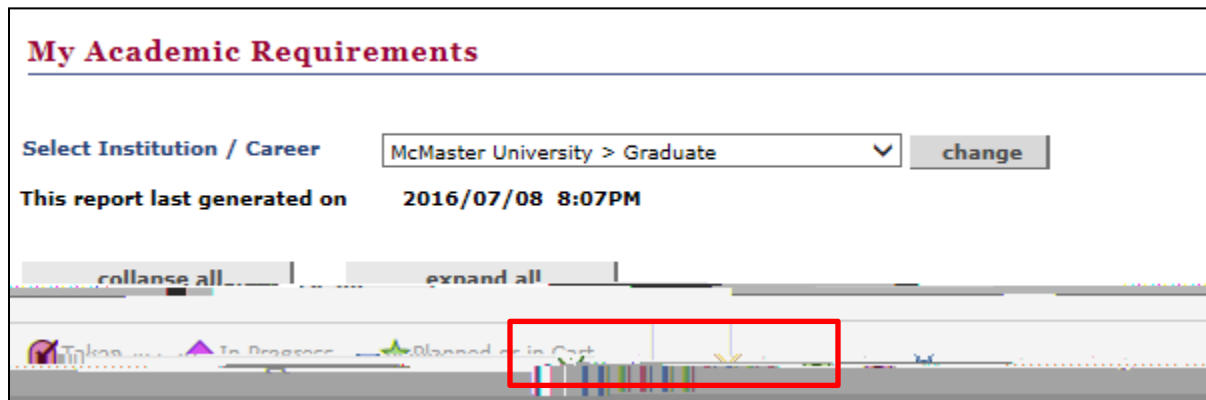


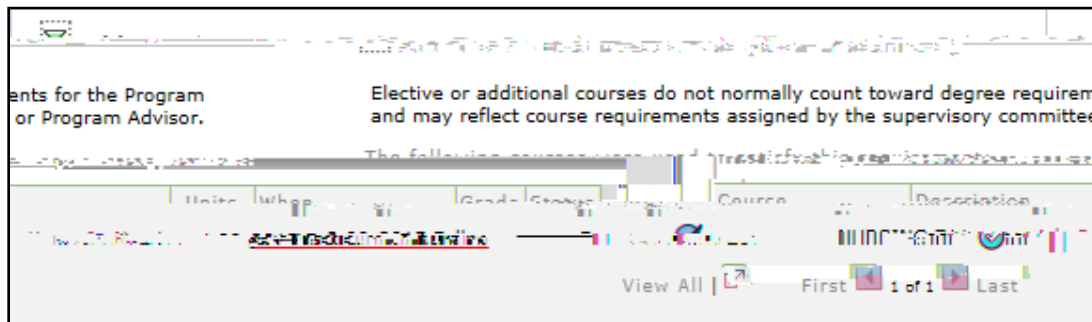
Academic Advisement for Graduate Students
