Terms of Reference

Purpose

The Agreement is to provide students in good standing enrolled in a graduate degree or diploma program at a CAGS member university the opportunity to avail themselves of courses offered at another member institution for transfer credit to the program at their institution (home). The definition of "home" is the institution in which the student applicant is enrolled and is expected to provide the graduate degree or diploma. The "host" is defined as the institution at which course credits can be obtained that can be counted toward a degree or diploma at the home institution.
